Safer Buckinghamshire Plan 2020-23

(a) Decisions

Buckinghamshire Council is a statutory member of the Safer Buckinghamshire Board which is the statutory Community Safety Partnership for Buckinghamshire. A key responsibility of the Safer Buckinghamshire Board is to maintain the Community Safety Plan for Buckinghamshire, based upon the strategic assessment of crime and community safety in the county, public engagement and other insight into crime and the causes of crime in Buckinghamshire.

The Safer Buckinghamshire Plan 2020-2023 was approved by the Safer Buckinghamshire Board on 21st July 2020. The Plan is in Appendix 1.

RESOLVED: Cabinet ENDORSED the Safer Buckinghamshire Plan (Community Safety Plan) 2020-2023.

(b) Reasons for decisions

The Council is a statutory member of the Buckinghamshire Community Safety Partnership known as the Safer Buckinghamshire Board - the Board is legally required to produce a Community Safety Plan which is called the Safer Buckinghamshire Plan.

The Council has a Duty to consider the crime and disorder implications of all its functions and activities. The Safer Buckinghamshire Plan and its delivery plans provide the framework for the Council to meet its obligations.

(c) Alternative options considered

As the Safer Buckinghamshire Plan is a statutory requirement, there were no other options to consider. In terms of the content of the Plan, there was extensive engagement with stakeholders on the priorities and actions to deliver those priorities; and these will remain under review by the Safer Buckinghamshire Board.
