Home to School Transport

I would like to thank both you and Sara Turnbull, Director for Transport Services for meeting with members of the Transport, Environment and Climate Change Select Committee earlier this month to discuss Home to School Transport.

It was a very useful meeting and gave Members a valuable insight into the scale and complexity of the task of providing Home to School transport in Buckinghamshire, which has obviously been complicated further by the Covid-19 pandemic.
