Title: Rights of Way Improvement Plan 2020 – 2030: Delivery Plan

The new Rights of Way Improvement Plan 2020-2030 (ROWIP) came into being on 1st April 2020 and it is now time to produce a 10-year ROWIP Delivery Plan (Action Plan) reflective of the aims and priorities of the new ROWIP.

It is proposed to structure the Delivery Plan around key themes and within 3-year timeframes, after an initial Year-1 plan. It is appreciated we are already nearly half way through the first year, but the following timeframes are proposed:

YEAR 1

YEAR 2-4

YEAR 5-7

YEAR 8-10

The Delivery Plan will be reviewed and progress shared with the Local Access Forum annually. A rolling review process over 10 years will enable the Rights of Way and Definitive Map Teams to adapt to any significant changes arising in Buckinghamshire Council and National Policies.

The Local Access Forum's comments are sought on the priorities described and timetable proposed within the "work in progress" draft plan set out in Appendix 4.

Is the Action Plan:

1. Sufficiently reflective of the ROWIP's objectives and is there anything missing?
2. Under ambitious, over ambitious or just right and realistic?
3. Correct in the proposed short, medium and long term actions?
4. Balanced between partners and council sharing delivery of the objectives?
5. Reflective of staff and financial resources?
