Pre submitted question

Levels of nitrogen dioxide in Marlow Town Centre have been in breach of air quality standards since 2010, and are showing only marginal improvement despite tighter emission standards for diesel vehicles. We think this situation is totally unacceptable, as well as illegal, and that more radical effective solutions need to be considered.

We would suggest that an investigation and public consultation should be launched looking at both full or partial pedestrianisation of the High Street, options for making surrounding streets one way to optimize traffic flows, provision for cycle lanes which this would allow and local parking provision to either maintain or increase footfall in the High Street.
