Decision

In line with the Street Naming and Numbering Policy agreed by Buckinghamshire Council on the 10 March 2020 and in consideration of the outcome of the consultation with local residents, and having due regard the Council's public sector equality duties as outlined in the attached EQIA, my decision is that the street name 'Slave Hill' is retained.

In line with the recommendations contained in the attached Report I would ask that officers work with the Parish Council to provide a sign on the site to give context to the street name, and to implement the further actions as identified in the EQIA.

Reasons for the decision

The reasons for my decision are more particularised in the attached Report dated 1 September 2020 which gives a full set of considerations that I have taken into account. I note particularly that the naming of Slave Hill is unconnected with the slave trade and I believe that anyone aware of the facts and historical context would not consider the name to glorify the slave trade and as an historical descriptor of the site is not offensive in itself. Nor do I consider the name a breach of the Council's policy on street names for the same reasons. Although I have taken into account all the coverage and comments relating to the name, I have also been mindful of the desire of the residents to retain the street name as evidenced by the consultation which was undertaken.
