<p><u>Home to School Transport Policy and Post-16 Transport Statement 2021/22 Consultation</u></p> <p>We are asking for views on proposals to update the content of the Policy and Statement by providing clarification and more detail to some areas. This is based on feedback we have received over the last 12 months and aims to provide clearer information and guidance to students and families so they can make informed choices about their school transport.</p> <p>We are also asking people to respond on proposed options for how transport for eligible post-16 students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) is arranged and paid for from September 2021. The consultation provides an overview summary, an Easy Read summary, associated documents, an online survey and a printed version of the survey.</p> <p>Everything is available on the consultation webpage and print versions are also available on request. We are also holding online consultation events where you can hear about possible changes to the Policy and ask questions. These will take place on Tuesday 10 November, 7-8pm or Thursday 19 November, 10.30-11.30am. <p>The future of New Chapel Surgery, Long Crendon</p> <p>Unity Health operates the site at New Chapel Surgery in Long Crendon and is consulting on their proposal to permanently close the site. First, they want to understand the views and needs of patients, to ensure any future proposals take these into account. The surgery was temporarily closed at the start of the Covid-19 lockdown in March. This was done in the interests of patient and staff safety, as the layout of the building made social distancing and managing the risk of infection virtually impossible. This situation has highlighted the fact that the Long Crendon surgery is no longer suitable for the needs of a modern GP practice - ageing building, no car parking facilities, poor disabled access, cannot be expanded/redeveloped to adequate standards. It is no longer possible for Unity Health to safely offer the level of service to patients that a modern, innovative GP practice would wish. So, Unity Health believe the best course of action is to permanently close the Long Crendon surgery and will need to apply to NHS Buckinghamshire Clinical Commissioning Group, which is responsible for commissioning all GP services in Bucks, to close the surgery.
