Drugs

We continue to focus on drug dealing and operate a strategic approach tackling drug supply and supporting vulnerable people who are targeted

'We can only continue to be successful with the support of our community'

Drugs Warrant:

-2 simultaneous drug warrants completed in Elmhurst/Southcourt area resulting in seizure of
£30,000 of Class A drugs
£8000 in cash
1kg Silver ingot
Mercedes AMG motor car

Civil Orders:

-Civil injunction for male associated with drug dealing and violent enforcement preventing entry to Aylesbury

-Partial Closure order for an address used for drug supply in Buckingham Park

What have we been up to...

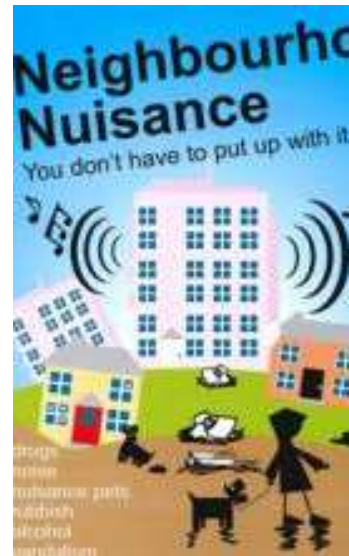
We obtained an **interim civil injunction** for a male that had been inappropriately approaching female's in Fairford Leys.

We obtained a **civil injunction** on a regular street drinker which now prevents him being in the Town centre.

We conducted a **Burglary prevention operation** coinciding with the clocks going back. This resulted in hundreds of individual engagements and the pursuit and arrest of 3 suspects that had committed a spate of Thefts From Motor Vehicles.

We conducted **knife crime reduction** activity as part of Operation Neptune resulting in 39 Stop Searches (2 knives seized). His Knife sweeps of playing fields. 78 knives placed in an amnesty bin'.

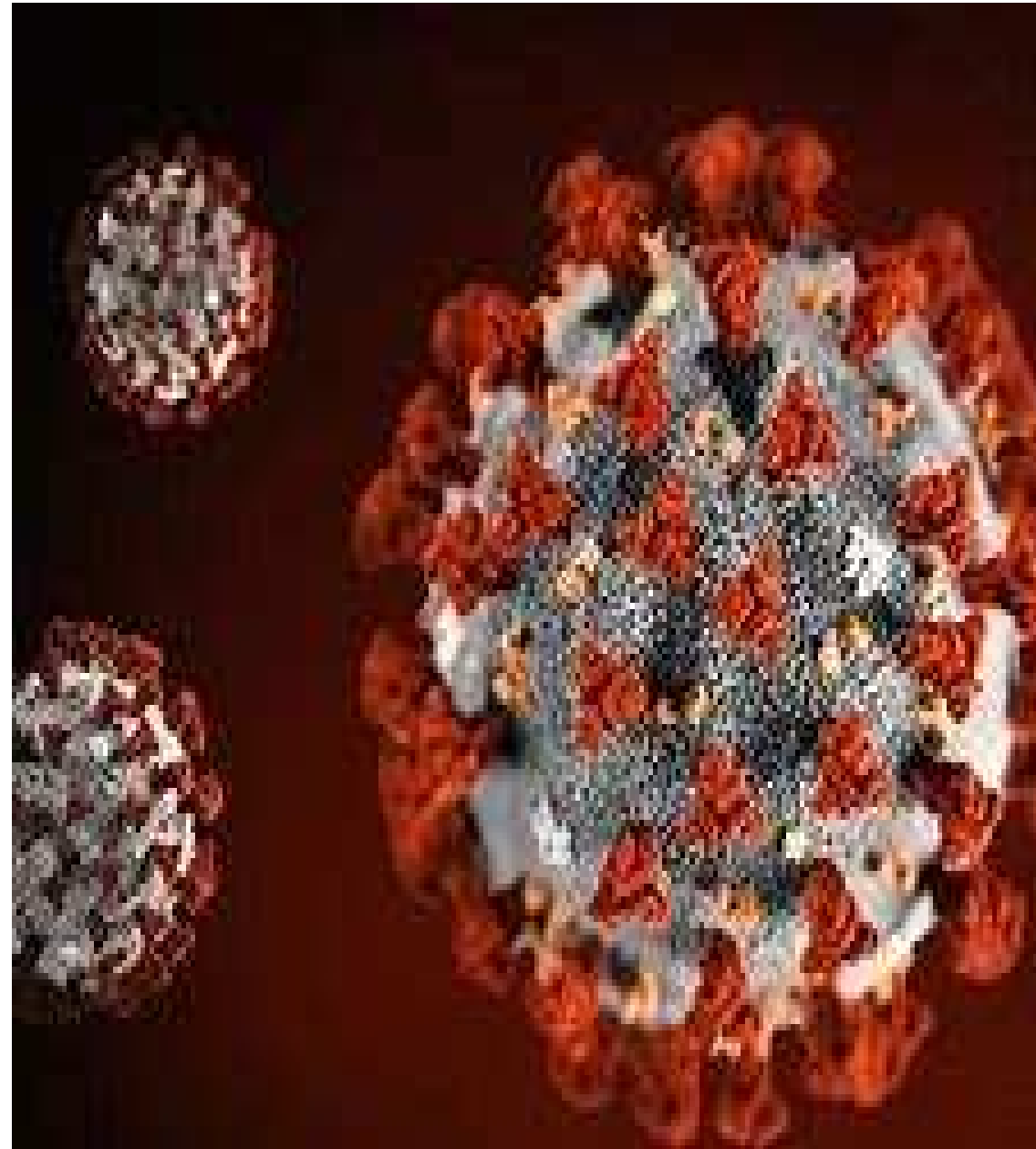
Covid-19
