12 Oct 2020

### **LG05.20 - Wye Dene, High Wycombe, Proposed Waiting Restrictions**

The Leader:

- **AUTHORISED** the making of the Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) as set out in this report.
- **AGREED** that the Traffic Regulation Order be made as advertised at Statutory Consultation but with the following amendments:
  - i. The two marked bus stops outside and opposite York House on Chequers Avenue be made 24 hour bus stop clearways to ensure these locations are kept clear of vehicles.
- **AGREED** that responders to the Statutory Consultation be informed of the decision.

### **CP02.20 - Public Spaces Protection Orders within Buckinghamshire**

The Leader **AGREED**:

To extend the following Public Spaces Protection Orders for two years, until October 2022:

- Buckingham Town Centre
- Winslow and Steeple Claydon
- West End Road, High Wycombe
- Parks and Open Spaces, Aylesbury

This decision is being taken under 'special urgency' provisions in order to meet renewal timescales.

**LG06.20 - Chalfonts Waiting Review**

The Leader:

- a) **AUTHORISED** the Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) for the scheme outlined in this report. Noting that it is different to the one that was advertised as part of the Statutory Consultation process.
- b) **AGREED** that the Traffic Regulation Order be made as advertised at Statutory Consultation but with the following amendments:
  - The proposed Permit Parking zone located off Gravel Hill, Chalfont St Peter (Plan AE72) not to be implemented as there was insufficient support for the proposal during the consultation.
  - The Permit Parking Zone times proposed at Ellwood Rise, Chalfont St Giles (Plan AE74) are changed from Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm excluding Bank Holidays to Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm and Saturdays 8am to 12 noon. This was after representations from affected residents were received advising that the prescribed hours should be extended as above.
- c) **AGREED** that responders to the Statutory Consultation be informed of the decision.

**LG07.20 - Malthouse Way/Barley, Marlow - Waiting Parking Restrictions**

The Leader **AGREED** to:

- A. Acknowledge the correspondence received to the consultation and determine that no objection remains unresolved**
- B. Authorise the Making of the traffic regulation order as advertised**
- C. Instruct the restrictions to be implemented by TfB;**

**To proceed to award the contract for the waste management and treatment services of green, food, bulky and wood waste to the preferred bidder (Bidder B).**

**ED04.20 - Maids Moreton CE School**

The Leader AGREED to the proposal by the governing board of Maids Moreton Church of England (CE) School that the school from September 2021 expands its age range. The school presently takes children up to the end of Key Stage 1 (KSI) and if the proposal is agreed children would continue at the school until the end of Key Stage 2 (KSII). The school undertook a public consultation on the proposed change and then held a representation period for people to comment on the proposal and there was overwhelming support for the proposed change.
