

Gerrards Cross Town Council Updates

Here is the report from Gerrards Cross Town Council for the Community Board meeting tomorrow. Sorry it is late, this is ongoing work and many of these items were updated only yesterday.

Gerrards Cross Town Council report for the Community Board on 11 February 2021.

1. Expanding Council office capacity/staffing for additional Buckinghamshire County Devolved work/Community Hub calls.
2. Reporting and removing recent spate of graffiti around Gerrards Cross.
3. Concern about lack of road/footpath sweeping, leaves still around since last autumn.
4. The Woodlands residential street resurfacing was only half done last year by TfB and never completed.
5. Packhorse Rd by Tesco lights remains in a dreadful state, vehicle crossing lanes to avoid moonscape.
6. Fibre Optic installation throughout Gerrards Cross indiscriminately digging up roads and footpaths and not clearing resulting mess.
7. Climate change statement – see our policy document, now on our website.
8. CCTV installation on hold awaiting excessive costs of Buckinghamshire Council new regulations.
9. Considering setting up Medical facilities in Gerrards Cross, currently depend on oversubscribed/inaccessible facilities in Chalfont St Peter.
10. Heavy use of East and West Commons during lockdown increasing footpath maintenance, holly clearing and need for more exercise equipment.
11. Concern about hedges restricting width of footpaths, cutting back and asking residents to cut back.
12. Continuing with Pothole Pilot scheme on non-category 1 on non-A and B roads. Also pavements repairs, which are very costly. Limited as funded by precept only.
13. Concerns about quality of road resurfacing on Windsor and Fulmer Roads, raised with local Buckinghamshire County Member.
14. Wapseys Wood traveller site on A40 ongoing illegal expansion raised with local Buckinghamshire County Member, requesting Emergency Stop Notice to be issued.
