



# Report to Pension Fund Board

**Title:** **i-Connect/Pensions 'online' Update**

## Executive summary

1.1 This report is to provide the Board with an update on the roll-out of i-Connect to scheme employers and the 'my pension online' service for scheme members.

## Content of report

### 1.2 'My Pension Online'

The online service continues to be standard practice for scheme members to receive communications from the administration team as well as using to update personal details & obtain pension estimates.

Overall, 28.54% of membership of the Buckinghamshire Pension Fund are fully registered to use this service, with a further 7.09% partially registered. A breakdown between membership status can be seen below.

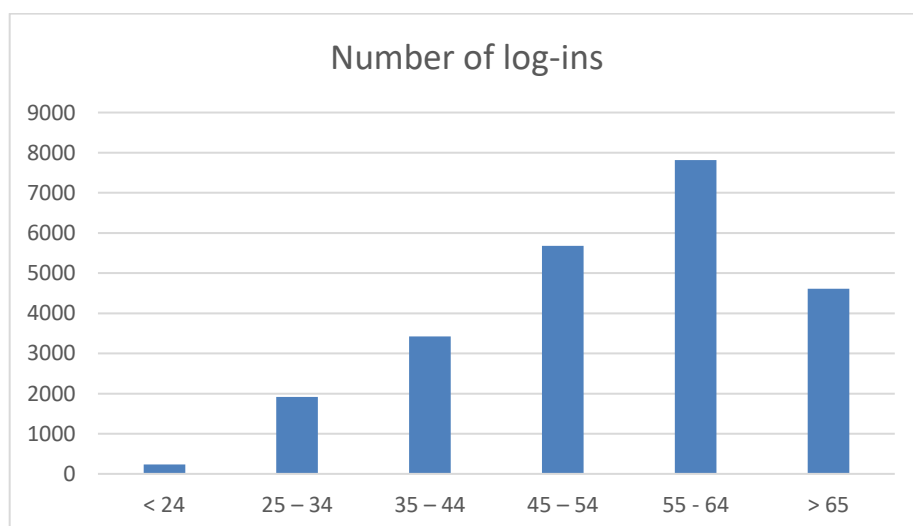
Targeted communications to those who have partially registered are being worked on with a letter being issued to all pensioner scheme members who are partially registered or not registered shortly.

We continue to report usage of the 'my pension online' facility on a monthly basis. This provides us with useful information regarding who is using the service and what for. Between 1 October 2020 & the end of February 2021, there has been a total of 22,371 log ins with the majority of these being from active scheme members.

Through the 'my pension online' service, scheme members can run benefit calculations, update contact details & death grant nominations and view communications from the Benefit Administration team including benefit statements and retirement packs. The table below provides a breakdown of the number of actions taken by scheme members between 1 October 2020 & 28 February 2021.

In terms of the age range for registered scheme members, the graph below provides a breakdown. Of the total, the highest number of registered members are those closer to retirement age. This also corresponds with the log-ins where the highest number of log ins are from those registered scheme members who are between age 55-64.



## **i-Connect**

This online submission facility allows employers to upload data directly onto the pensions software system and removes the current requirement for employers to submit data on a monthly/annual basis via spreadsheet. At the end of February 2021, 122 employers had been onboarded and were successfully submitting data on a monthly basis via this service which covers approximately 25% of active scheme membership.

All employers who are not yet using i-Connect have now been issued with communication confirming that they will either need to be live from 1 April 2021 or have an onboarding date agreed otherwise charges will be imposed on a monthly basis where data is submitted in an alternative format.

The Systems team have managed to re-start discussions with the fund's biggest employer, which had previously been put on hold. This employer accounts for approximately 35% of all active scheme membership. It is hoped that testing with 37 Academies that fall under this employer will begin testing shortly with the main payroll to follow.
