

Executive Decisions Made by Officers

The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) Regulations 2012 place new requirements on local authorities relating to executive decisions. That is decisions made by the Cabinet, individual Portfolio Holders, Sub Committee or Joint Committees. This also includes executive decisions made by officers under delegated authority.

In order to comply with these new requirements officers must ensure that as soon after an officer has made an executive decision, including those made under delegated authority, that this form is completed and sent to <u>democraticservices@chiltern.gov.uk</u> for publication on the Council's website in accordance with the Regulations.

In order to comply with the Regulation 13, Democratic Services will publish a written statement based on the information provided in the following form:

That, provided that Wycombe District Council obtains the necessary approvals, and following consultation with the Leader as required under the Scheme of Delegation:

a. The Chief Executive exercised his Power of Urgency and agreed to extend the existing contract with Serco from 4 March 2020 on terms to be agreed by the Head of Environment in consultation with the relevant Portfolio Holder and the Heads of Finance and Legal and Democratic Services; and

b. Cabinet be advised of the exercise of the Power of Urgency as required by the Scheme of Delegation.

- **4. Reasons for the decision:** the proposals currently under discussion with Serco are not strictly within the terms of the existing Cabinet delegation to achieve a common expiry date with the SBDC Biffa contract.
