

## Non- Executive Delegated Decisions Made by Officers

Regulation 7 of the Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations 2014 requires a written record to be produced as soon as reasonably practicable after an Officer has made a decision under delegation. This means that in order to comply with these new requirements, Officers discharging delegated powers which would otherwise have been taken by the relevant local government body, or a committee, subcommittee of that body or a joint committee in which that body participates, but it has been delegated to an officer of that body either under a specific express authorisation; or under a general authorisation to officers to a) grant a permission or licence; b) affect the rights of an individual or c) award a contract or incur expenditure which in either case materially affects the Council's financial position must complete the form below.

- 1. Name and role of officer: Chief Executive
- 2. Date of decision: 7th February 2018
- **3. Summary of the decision:** The creation of two new posts in the Planning and Economic Development Service. One a Principal Economic Development Officer and one an Economic Development Officer.
- **4. Reasons for the decision:** These posts were identified as needed in order to provide focussed resources to support on the delivery of the Economic Development Strategy.
