Made: 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2015  
Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Aylesbury Vale District Council (“the Council”) in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated December 2014:

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3), 98(4) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

**Citation and commencement**

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Aylesbury Vale (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015.
- (2) This Order comes into force:-
  - (a) for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of councillors, on the day after it is made;
  - (b) for all other purposes, the Order comes into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

## **Interpretation**

### **2. In this Order -**

“district”	means the district of Aylesbury Vale;
“existing”	means existing on the date this Order is made;
“map”	means the map marked “Map referred to in the Aylesbury Vale (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015” and deposited in accordance with Section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number;
“new parish”	means the parish constituted by article 4;
“ordinary day of election of councillors”	has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983: and
“registration officer”	means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

## **Effect of Order**

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

## **Constitution of a new parish**

4. (1) A new parish comprising the area outlined with a red line on the map, shall be constituted within the district.
- (2) The name of the new parish shall be Berryfields.
- (3) In consequence of paragraph (1) of this article, the area of the new parish shall cease to be part of the existing parish of Quarrendon.

## **Calculation of budget requirement for the parish of Berryfields**

5. For the purpose of regulation 3 of the Local Government Finance (New Parishes) (England) Regulations 2008 there is specified in relation to the parish of Berryfields in the sum of £31,500.





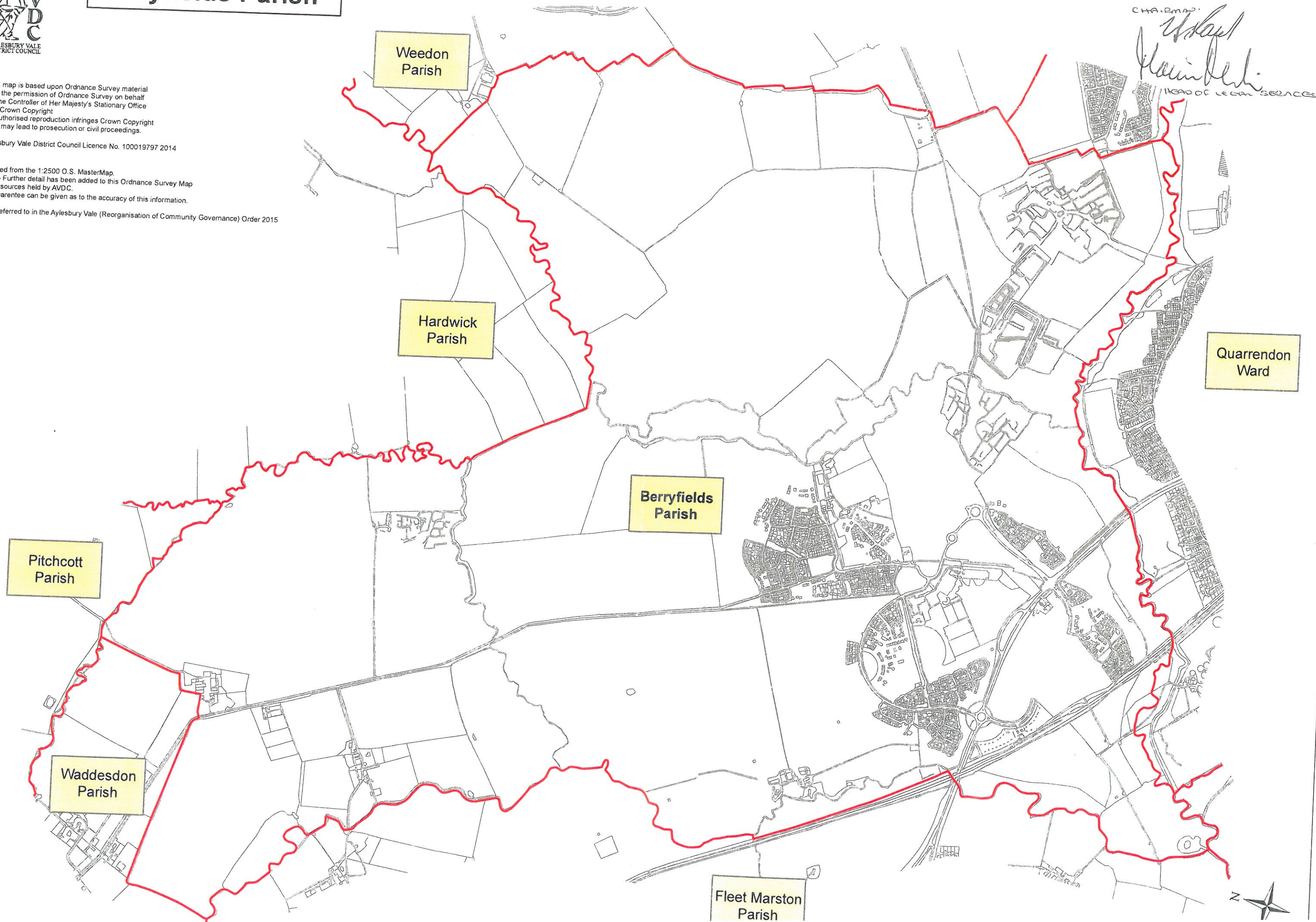

#### **Parish Council for the parish of Berryfields**

6. (1) There shall be a parish council for the parish of Berryfields.
- (2) The name of that council shall be "The Parish Council of Berryfields".

#### **Election for the parish of Berryfields**

7. The election of all parish councillors for the parish of Berryfields shall be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

#### **Number of parish councillors for the parish of Berryfields**

8. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Berryfields shall be 12.

#### **Number of parish councillors for the parish of Stewkley**

9. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Stewkley shall be varied from 8 to 9.

#### **Annual meeting of parish council**

10. The annual meeting of the new parish council in 2015 shall be convened by the Democratic Services Manager of Aylesbury Vale District Council. The meeting shall take place no later than 14 days after the day on which the councillors elected to the new parish council take office

#### **Electoral register**

11. The registration officer of the district shall make such rearrangement of, or adaption of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

#### **Transfer of property, rights and liabilities**

12. All land, property, rights and liabilities vested in or attaching to the area of that part of the existing parish of Quarrendon transferring to the Parish Council of Berryfields shall by virtue of this Order be transferred to and vest in or attach to the Parish Council Berryfields.

**Order date**

13. This Order date is in accordance with article 1(2) for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**  
(This is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Aylesbury Vale District Council for the new parish of Berryfields, the alteration of the area of the parish of Quarrendon, the creation of a council for the parish of Berryfields within the district of Aylesbury Vale and changes to the number of councillors elected at Stewkley Parish Council.

The parish of Berryfields will be created with effect from 1 April 2015. The electoral agreements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

Article 7 provides for parish elections in the parish of Berryfields in 2015, and then to continue according to the established system of parish elections every four years.

Article 8 specifies the number of parish councillors for the new parish of Berryfields.

Article 11 obliges the Electoral Registration Officer to make any necessary amendments to the electoral register to reflect the new electoral arrangements.
