

## 2016 European Union Referendum

A referendum on whether the United Kingdom should remain in or leave the European Union was held on Thursday, 23 June 2016.

The question on the ballot paper was:

Should the United Kingdom remain a member of the European Union or leave the European Union?

- Remain a member of the European Union
- Leave the European Union

The results for Chiltern were as below.
