Unfortunately I need to give an objection to the request to extend the licensing late hours license and for live/recorded music for the premises Lieviti on Spittal Street in Marlow. I live close to the Butchers Tap and know from experience any license for music whether recorded or live can be highly intrusive as this part of Marlow is guite dense with buildings and with the road being narrow, further exacerbated by the late alcohol license they are requesting and the impact with customers leaving.

While this was intrusive from the Butchers Tap very close to Leiviti they only had music once every 3 weeks or so and furthermore the music stopped at 10:30 so for us residents helping to reduce the impact; with this experience I am greatly concerned with this more general and extended use licence and so would unfortunately need to object.

The property I rent is at the back of Leivit and would be heavily impacted along with other properties in Crown Lane, while the narrow front road will strengthen noise reflections and also impact residents there (experience hearing road traffic with the occasional aggresive driver). From a personal standpoint for this property it would be guite unbearable as it already has to exist with their recent (within Covid period before they opened) installed commercial related exhaust vent that can be heard within the flat even with windows shut and is guite wearying without it also going on for many more hours (currently in use up to 9pm to 9:30 pm).
