Approval of Mentmore Conservation Area Draft Appraisal and Management Plan for Public Consultation

Purpose:

1. AVDC has reviewed the existing Conservation Area at Mentmore.
2. Approval of Conservation Area and Management Plan consultation is an Executive function that has been delegated to the Corporate Planner, Customer Fulfilment.
3. Formal approval of the final Conservation Area boundary is undertaken by Cabinet , on behalf of Council, following the period of consultation outlined below.
4. Formal approval of the Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Plan is undertaken by the Corporate Planner, Customer Fulfilment, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Planning and Enforcement, following approval of the boundary by Cabinet.

Public consultation will be undertaken over a 7 week period between 16 September 2019 and 8 November 2019. All households and businesses in the areas where changes are proposed will be notified at the start of the consultation.

On the evening of 30 September 2019 and the afternoon of 2 October 2019 the Conservation Areas Officer will attend public meetings at Mentmore to present the Conservation Area Review. During those meetings, members of the public will be able to ask the Officer questions relating to the proposed designation.

Decision:
