

CABINET MEMBER DECISION NOTICE

The Deputy Leader / Cabinet Member for Communities has taken the following decision:

FREE PARKS HIRE FOR PHYSICAL ACTIVITY AND TENNIS FOR FREE SCHEME

(a) Decision(s)

- (i) To approve the introduction of a Free Park Hire Scheme to promote physical activity.
- (ii) To approve the setting up of a Tennis for Free Scheme at Vale Park.

(b) Reason(s) for decision(s)

Option (a) from the 'Alternative Options considered' was recommended as it was felt that this would provide the greatest incentive to hirers and better contribute to the aims of the Bucks Physical Activity Strategy. AVDC already offers discounts to charitable and public sector organisations hiring our land, with a discount of 20% for public sector and 40% for charities.

(c) Alternative options considered

- (a) To offer the identified parks for hire free of charge when hirer applicant meets specified criteria.
- (b) To offer a discount for the hire of the identified parks when the hirer applicant meets specified criteria.
- (c) To not offer any additional discount or free hire scheme, but to aim to promote the current hire of AVDC land information more widely to potential hirers who may deliver physical activity opportunities.
