Permits are not transferable from one user to another.</p> <p>The permit cannot be used for parking in the vicinity of your base/place of work for any purpose.</p> <p>The permit may only be used in free bays, residents or pay and display bays. It does not entitle the user to park in loading bays, disabled bays, taxi rank s, bays which have been suspended, or on yellow lines where usual restrictions apply. The permit cannot be used to park in car parks.</p>
School permits	12 months	£26.00	12 months	<p>Any person responsible for a child or children attending a school situated within a controlled parking zone may apply to the Council for the issue to them of a school permit for the parking of a vehicle of the class specified in a parking place in which such permits are valid; provided that the Council may require such specific and supportive information as it considers appropriate to satisfy itself that the applicant is entitled to a school permit.</p>
