The Member has taken the following decision.

The decision will take effect on Tuesday, 04 February 2014.

Title

Demolition of the public conveniences and transfer of the resulting land and car park at Red Lion Way, Wooburn to Wooburn and Bourne End Parish Council, together with land at Sappers Field, Harvest Hill, Wooburn Green

Decision Taken

That the decisions (i) to demolish the public conveniences at Red Lion Way, Wooburn car park and to transfer the resulting land and existing car park to Wooburn and Bourne End Parish Council; and (ii) to transfer the site known as Sappers Field, Harvest Hill, Wooburn Green to Wooburn and Bourne End Parish Council be approved.

Reasons for Decision

To reduce the Council's revenue costs and enable the local community to have control over the car park and another site.

Consultation Undertaken

Consultation has been carried out with the Parish Council. Sappers Field is a public open space and the decision to dispose of it has been advertised for two weeks in a local newspaper, and any objections to the proposed disposal considered.
