Reasons for Decision

With regard to the Council's duties and responsibilities to secure best value, and acknowledging that joint arrangements have significant potential to reduce both administrative and service costs, the Council has decided to make joint procurement arrangements for the collection of dog waste.

Consultation Undertaken

No public consultation has been carried out in respect of this service as there is no direct contact with the customer. The service is provided both for dog owners who use the bins and those who do not own dogs who benefit from a cleaner environment.

The Council's Environmental Co-ordinator and Equality Officer have been consulted in respect of this project and the Head of Finance and District Solicitor have been consulted in respect of the procurement.

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
