Title

Variation to method of setting pest control charges paid by the public for those services from Council set charges to those set by the contractor providing this service.

Decision Taken

That the pest control charges paid by the public for these services are varied from those charges set by the Council to those offered by the contractor providing this service.

Reasons for Decision

Through the procurement process for a pest control service the Council has endeavoured to ensure we obtain the most cost effective charges for the public that will be paid by them for pest control treatments. As such we need to vary the fees that the Council has set for these services to those now offered by the successful tenderer, as this will ensure that the public as a whole will pay less for these services. It should be noted that the Council obtains no income from these charges as they are retained by the contractor.

Consultation Undertaken

No consultation has taken place in respect of the provision of this service. It is assumed that the public would wish to pay less for any service received, presuming that the quality of service is maintained.
