Reasons for Decision

Due to the large demand of searches, and the additional workload to answer the planning questions, it is necessary to implement a small increase in the land charges search fee to fund the additional resource of 0.5FTE to undertake this work.

The Council's Strategic Management Board has considered this matter and are supportive of the proposal. There has not been an increase in the fee for land charges for a number of years, and the proposed new level would also bring us into parity with our neighbouring authorities.
