#### **Title**

Making the Longwick-cum-Ilmer Neighbourhood Plan

#### **Decision Taken**

It be approved that,

- i) the Council “makes” i.e. adopts the Longwick-cum-Ilmer Neighbourhood Plan pursuant to the provisions of section 38(A)(4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as introduced by Schedule 9 of the Localism Act 2011), and
- ii) it be brought into force as part of the Development Plan for decision making on planning applications in Wycombe District.

#### **Date of Publication**

19 March 2018

#### **Reasons for Decision**

- a) To comply with the provisions of section 38(A)(4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004;
- b) To give full weight to the neighbourhood plan policies in decision-making as the Longwick-cum-Ilmer Neighbourhood Plan becomes part of Development Plan for decision making on planning applications in Wycombe District;
- c) To recognise the considerable efforts undertaken by the Parish Council to plan positively and sustainably for their parish area.

#### **Consultation Undertaken**

There has been significant consultation on the Longwick-cum-Ilmer Neighbourhood Plan throughout its production. This is detailed in the Consultation Statement submitted to the Council alongside the submission version of the plan. In addition, the District Council undertook a statutory 6 weeks consultation prior to examination. Prior to referendum, the plan (Consolidated Draft for Referendum version) was made

available to view on the Council's website and at the Council's offices, and on the Longwick-cum-Ilmer parish website.
