

**NOTICE OF INSTALLATION OF TIGER CROSSINGS AND ROAD HUMPS EMERALD WAY IMPROVEMENTS SCHEME**

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and Sections 90A-90F of the Highways Act 1980, and after consultation with the Secretary of State and Chief of Police intends to install new Tiger Crossings/road humps located as follows: **Rabans Lane** - The speed cushions will be located at a distance of 35m south-west of the Brunel Road junction with Rabans Lane. **Fowler Road** - The speed cushions will be located at a distance of 72m south of the St Anne's Road junction with Fowler Road. **Fowler Road, Bracken Way junction** - The speed cushions will be located at a distance of 5m south of the Bracken Way junction with Fowler Road. Dimension and specifications:- Raised Parallel (Tiger) Crossing, 75mm in height and 4.3m length constructed from Asphalt: The raised Tiger Crossing combines a pedestrian Zebra (2.4m length) with a crossing for people on bikes (1.5m length). The gap between the pedestrian Zebra and the crossing for bikes is 0.4m length. This gives a total of 4.3m length mentioned above. Length of Ramp is 1.875m and Ramp height is 75mm. Ramp width approximately: 7m for Rabans Lane, 5.5m for Fowler Road, 6m for Fowler Road, South of Bracken Way junction, (d) Give way markings will be signed either side. The raised tiger crossing combines a pedestrian zebra (2.4m length) with a crossing for people on bikes (1.5m length). The gap between the pedestrian zebra and the crossing for bikes is 0.4m length. This gives a total of 4.3m length mentioned above.
