

Action Group: Transport and Highways action group

The South West Chilterns Community Board have continued to hold regular Transport and Highways action group meetings this year over and above the recommended two.

Highways projects are both complex and costly in relation to the Board budget and careful consideration takes place on any application received into the Board.

Implementation of schemes can take time to come to fruition as there are many stages to progress through.

Following Unitary and the creation of Community Boards, an application deadline of September 30th has been set and many projects have been received, a project initiation document (PID) has been produced which outlines the application and the design elements.

Buckinghamshire Council are currently in a transitional phase with new contractors for Highways who are formally in place from 1 April 2023. It was agreed that applications would not be accepted by the Community Boards for September 2022 to allow some breathing space for outstanding projects to be completed during the 2022/2023 year.

Projects that are progressing currently are:

- South West Chilterns Parking Review
- A4155 Medmenham 40MPH extension
- School wigwags Wooburn Green
- 40 MPH limit Fawley
- School markings Wethered Road, Marlow
- Bollards Pound Lane, Marlow

There are other projects that are in the pipeline and waiting to be assigned to engineers and awaiting changing over to the new contractor.
