9 January - 12 February	Launch nominations Nominations open for 5 weeks Communications team supporting with publicity Community Boards share and promote in their local areas
13 February – 20 February	POB central working group collate nominations and create packs for community boards to complete shortlisting
27 February – deadline 6 March	Judging panels to select winners and highly commended.
7 March – 31 March	Certificates and trophies to be finalised with winner's details
1 April onwards	Celebrations and presentations to form part of annual engagement event.





- Promoting the awards and encouraging people to nominate
- Members of the board to promote through any media avenues that they are involved with (e.g. radio, local magazines)
- Sharing nomination form to all networks
- Taking part in a judging panel
- Notifying the POB team of the winners
- Putting plans together for presenting the awards at an in person event
- Support with the comms for winners, promote them locally
