

1. PSDF RELATED DEVELOPMENT

FIVE POINTS ROUNDABOUT

- Application validated November 2022
- Determination deadline February 2023
- No outstanding objections from Statutory Consultees
- Awaiting determination by Local Planning Authority
- Procurement process underway by Pinewood Studios
- Detailed design (s.278) to commence if planning permission is approved
- Target start date summer / autumn 2023

Set For More Futures Festival

Pinewood Studios welcomed over 3,700 students from across the UK for Futures Festival 2022. 23 Secondary schools and colleges from across Buckinghamshire attended. The key aim of the event was to inspire and educate students about the career opportunities across our booming industry which is currently facing a skills shortage. Those who visited met employers and industry professionals, took part in workshops, attended talks and experienced Pinewood Studio's filmmaking facilities.





3. ITEMS RAISED BY PARISHES

- Tree Planting
 - Six oak trees have been planted to replace trees that died
- Litter at the site boundaries
 - Monthly patrols
 - Low level rabbit wire installed along Black Park boundary
- Waiting taxies / private hire vehicles
 - A taxi waiting area is being explored on site
- Parking and traffic management
 - Introduction of the 'Sky Visitor' management system online booking system
 - Construction traffic related to five new stages has now ended, reducing HGV congestion at site entrance
