Wexham Parish Council funding report

This year Wexham Parish Council made two funding applications which were successful and this report provides and overview as to how the monies were used.

George Green Juniors Football Club, Storage Shed - £4846.00

The Harvey Memorial recreation grounds are the home of George Green Juniors FC, this club has multiple teams from the ages of 5-14 it is a diverse club of both offering football with both boy and girl teams playing under FA guidance.

The management of the club approached Wexham Parish for the provision of equipment storage, space within the Harvey Hall is at a premium so it was felt that if a shed could be provided they would then have a self sufficient and secure base.

Wexham Parish Council retain the ownership of the new shed and it is provided the the club whilst they are using our facilities, the shed is now included within the clubs fees for use of grounds.

The pictures below show the building which was supplied by Nucrete a company which Wexham Parish Council had a track record, we expect the building to have a life span of 20 years plus if we compare it with the existing pre-cast buildings in the adjacent location.

The second project application was for funding towards activities relating to the Queens Jubilee Wexham Parish Council applied for a maximum grant £4000 on the understanding that we would keep within this with an expected spending of a lesser amount.

The grant settlement was : £2158..96

Wexham Parish Council decided that it would endevour to only purchase items for the Jubilee celebrations that had an amount of longevity, the monies enabled us to purchase bunting and flags of civic quality which can be used on other events such as this years Coronation.

Part funding went to St Marys Church to purchase advertising banners & flags suitable for all occasions. Part funding purchased crockery for The Womens Fellowship which again will have perpetual use.

Funding also went into staging two bus shelter exhibitions and our Party on the Park, exhibition materials have already been recyled to the Black Park Model Boat Club
