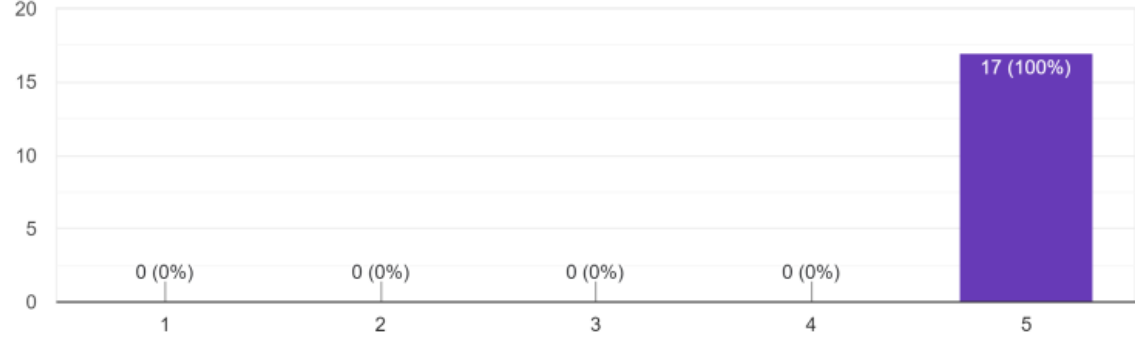

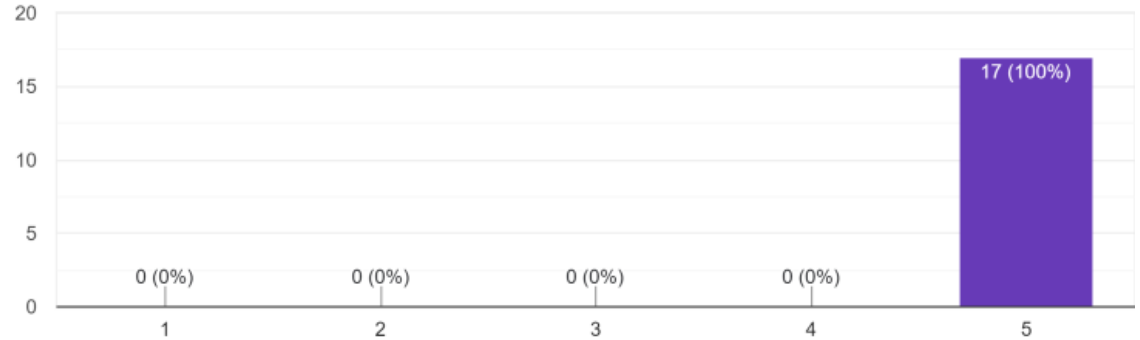
How would you rate overall enjoyment?

17 responses



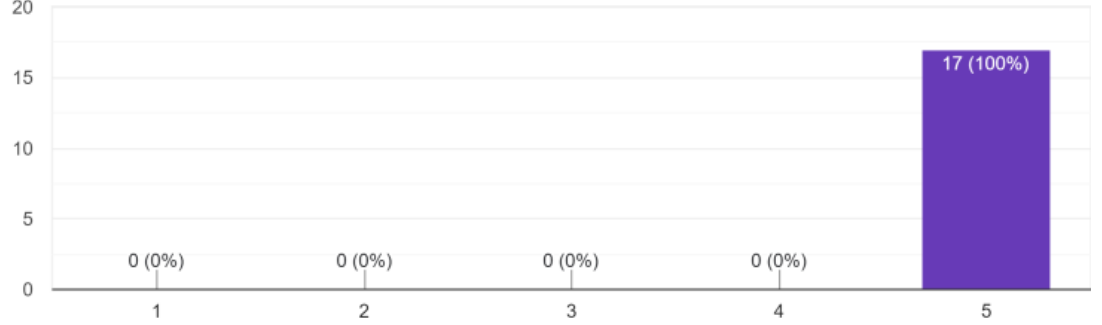
How was the quality of the delivery?

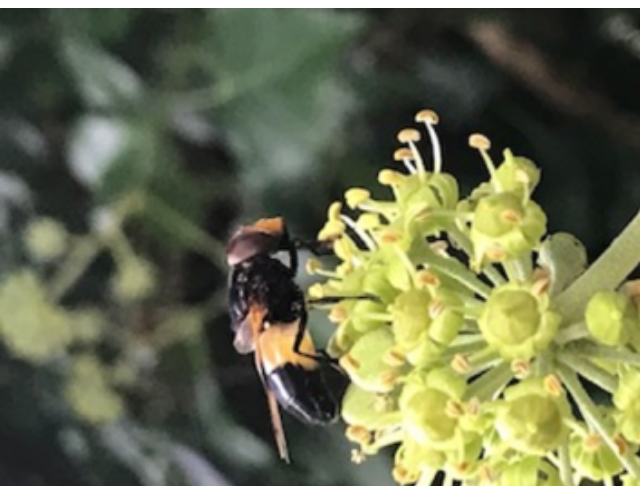
