Buckinghamshire Councils Aims and Objectives



Achieve net zero carbon emissions for Buckinghamshire as a whole by 2050.

- **The qualifying criteria for an Energy Doctor visit are:**
 - household income £30,000 or less (before any deductions); OR the household is in receipt of means tested benefits or a member of a household has a disability
 - AND
 - the domestic property has an energy performance certificate rating of D, E, F, or G
 - AND
 - You own or rent the property via a private rental agreement

 - Visits will prioritised for those who meet these eligibility criteria and live in [Opportunity Bucks](#) areas.

Providing advice to encourage behavioural change

Turning down the thermostat by 1°C can reduce your heating costs by up to 8%

You can save around 5-10% on your gas bill if you turn the 'pre-heat' off on your combi boiler

You can save around £55 (45kgCO₂e) a year just by remembering to turn your appliances off standby mode.

Reducing shower time by 1 minute
Could save £45 on metered water supply
Up to £52 on energy costs

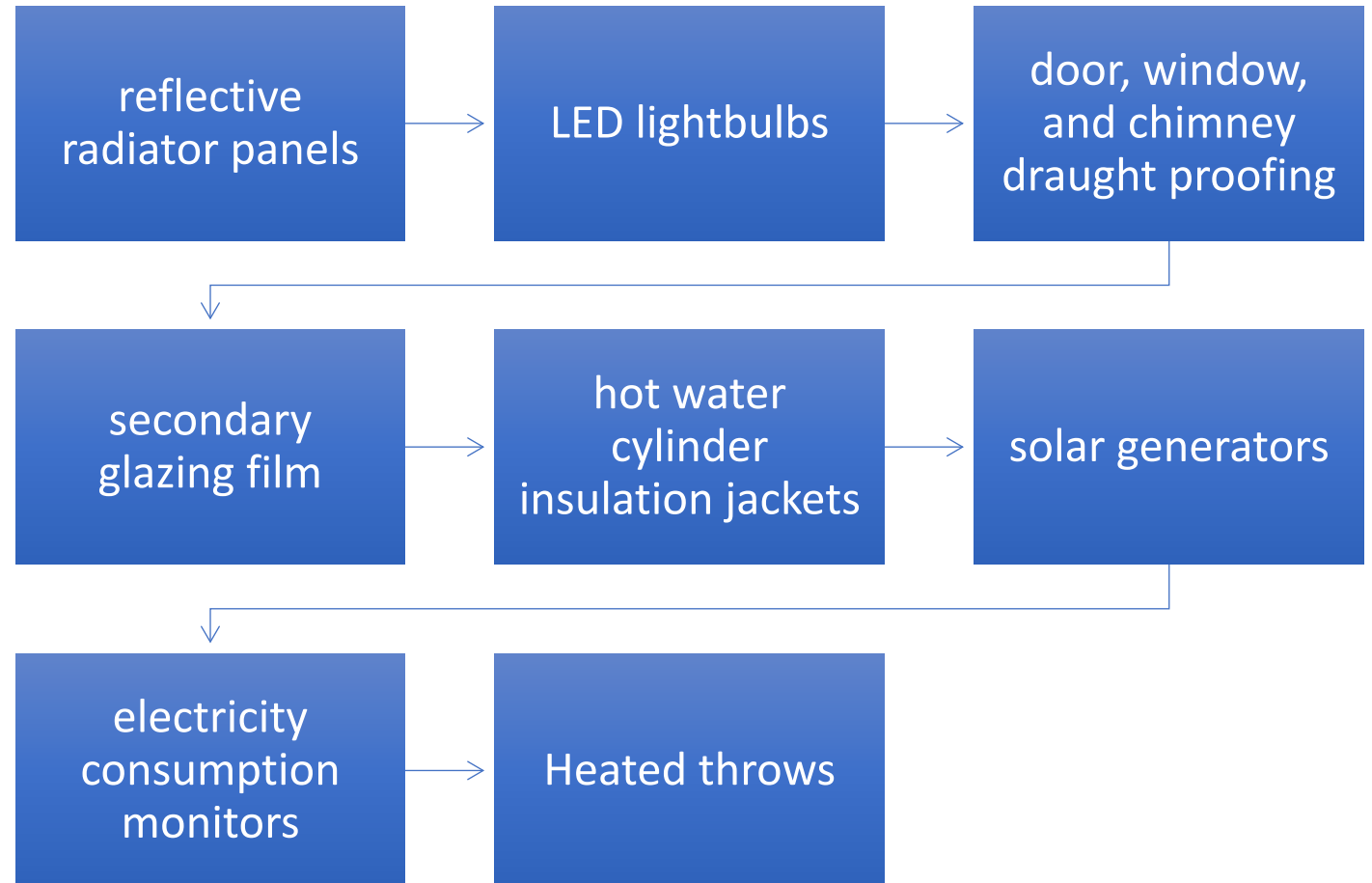
Turning appliances off at the socket could save you up to £70 a year

Washing clothes at a lower temperature could save you up to £40 a year

Using your tumble dryer less could save you £70 a year

Closing all your curtains and blinds at night

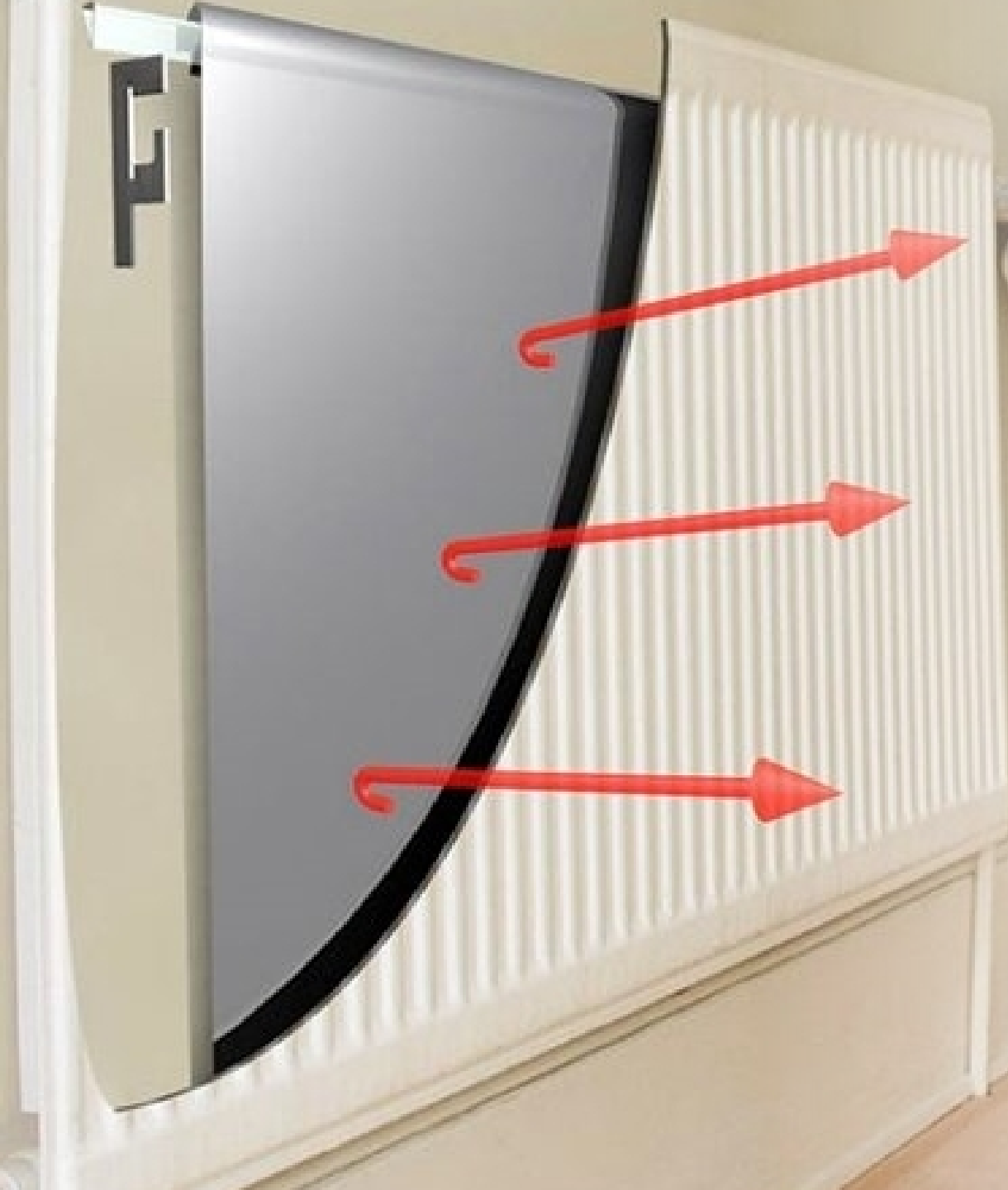

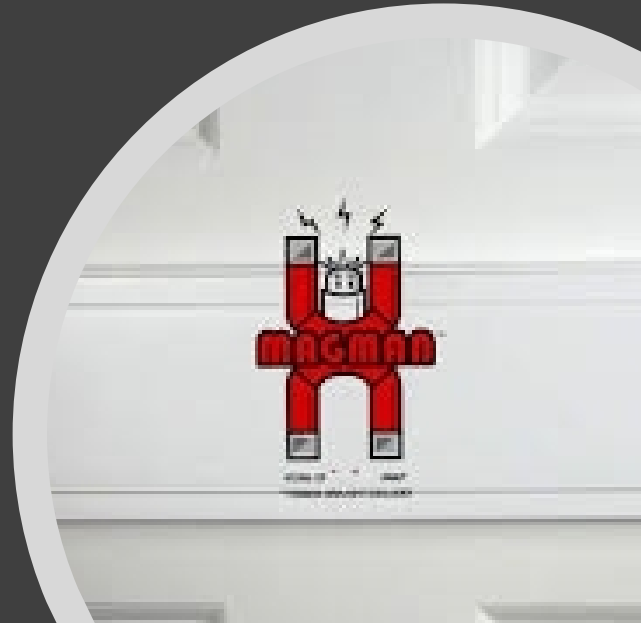
Reflective Radiator Panels

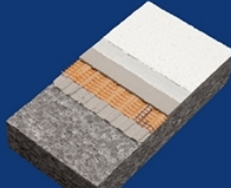
