Statutory Consultation for the implementation of Traffic Calming Features in the Castlefield Area of High Wycombe

Buckinghamshire Highways are proposing to introduce traffic calming measures in the Castlefield Area in High Wycombe. These measures are designed to limit and deter anti-social driving from occurring in the area and to improve safety amenities for road users and pedestrians. Such proposed measures include speed humps, raised tables, modifying junctions, and chicanes.
