Cabinet Member Priorities for Environment & Climate Change

Climate Change

- Buckinghamshire Council has made it a corporate priority to improve our environment. We will address climate change by taking wide-ranging actions now to reduce our carbon emissions, from planting trees to environmentally-focussed planning.
- Preparation of a Climate Change Strategy is underway
- We will aim to agree a carbon reduction target for Buckinghamshire Council's operations and consider steps such as:
 - Identifying opportunities for energy efficiency and/or renewable generation technology on corporate sites, and developing investment proposals
 - Initiating a review of agricultural policy to ensure that farm ownership can play a major part in how we reduce our carbon footprint
 - Identifying tree planting opportunities across Buckinghamshire

Cabinet Member Priorities for Environment & Climate Change

Household Recycling Centres

- Ensuring we anticipate the needs for Buckinghamshire's residents and business in the future, bidding into capital funding where required.
- The process to re-procure the Household Recycling Centre service has commenced with the intention of a new contract for delivery being in place by 1st April 2022.

Southern Waste Collection Contracts

- Proactively ensuring a smooth transition between contracts for waste collection in the south of the county.
- We must not assume that moving between contracts will be a straight forward, and must design and plan to ensure that Buckinghamshire's residents and businesses do not experience a disruption in service.

Cabinet Member Priorities for Logistics

- Providing an effective home to school transport service for all families that require it and supporting schools to reopen through resuming transport
- The creation of an effective and financially sustainable client and home to school transport service
- The creation of a countywide parking policy; and a parking strategy and integrated parking team that is effective, sustainable, cost effective, meets the needs of residents' and businesses, and generates increasing income
