NOTICE OF DETERMINATION AND ORDER-MAKING DECISION

Buckinghamshire Council hereby gives notice that the above application submitted by Mr R Collard on 15 September 2015 for an Order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to modify the Definitive Map and Statement has been determined.

The Council has investigated the matter and consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the application relates.

The Council has determined that the route has already been created and added to the Definitive Map and Statement by a Deed of Dedication and therefore rejects the application.
