Licensing Act 2003

**Re: Application for a Premises Licence – German Doner Kebab, 84 Cambridge Street,
Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire, HP20 1BA**

I am an authorised officer of the Council as set out in Section 69(2)(d) of the Licensing Act 2003. I fulfil the duties of a Responsible Authority as defined by Section 69(4)(e) of the Act in terms of the Council's statutory functions associated with the minimisation or prevention of risks associated with pollution to the environment or harm to human health.

I have reviewed the above application documentation in the context of what steps, if any, are appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives as described in Section 4 of the Licensing Act 2003 and **wish to make a Representation against the granting of a premises licence on the terms set out in the application.**

Given the proximity of a number of dwellings to 84 Cambridge Street I believe that the above proposal would not promote the *prevention of public nuisance* objective set out in the Act as regards the late night liberation of noise from customers, use of kitchen plant, and delivery activity.

I have considered the mitigation measures set out in the application, as amended, as regards the control of noise. Whilst some of the proposed conditions do, in my opinion, do have merit others are insufficiently clear and therefore I do not believe that they, collectively, provide an adequate means of protecting local residents from the harmful effects of the proposals.

Finally, I am of the opinion that the application does not, overall, reflect the Licensing Authority's policy as set out in paragraph 1.5 of *Alcohol and entertainment licensing policy statement* of 24th January 2022.

I have provided a copy of this document to the applicant for this Premises Licence so that they may contact me to discuss my specific concerns with view to arriving at a mutually agreeable revised Operating Schedule; if such agreement is reached I understand that a Licensing Subcommittee will hold an expedited hearing to ratify this and grant a Premises Licence.

If, however, no such agreement is reached within the prescribed consultation period then I am mindful that this matter will be subject to formal determination by a full Licensing Subcommittee.
